

# COOKIE NOTICE

This Cookie Notice explains how Cranmore ("we" or "our") uses Cookies on our website.

## What are Cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text that are placed on your computer or mobile device by websites that you visit. Cookies are used to store and receive identifiers and other information on computers, phones and other devices. Cookies are created when you use your browser to visit a website that uses Cookies to keep track of your movements within the site, help you resume where you left off, remember your registered login, theme selection, preferences, and other customisation functions. Cookie technology encompasses the use of pixels, text file, java script and similar technologies. We refer to all of these technologies as Cookies.

## Why do we use Cookies?

Cookies help us deliver, protect and improve our website product by personalising content, tailoring services and advertisements, improving performance and efficiency with the use of metrics and providing security measures to keep you safe and secure.

## Types of Cookies

### Strictly Necessary & Always Active

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will then not work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

### ***Functional***

These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies then some or all of these services may not function properly.

### ***Performance***

These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance.

### ***Analytics***

We use Analytics cookies to collect information about how visitors use our website. These cookies collect information in the aggregate to give us insight into how our website is being used. For example, the number of users on a website, how long they stay on the site for, and what parts of the site they visit. This is also sometimes known as 'web audience measurement'. This work is often done 'in the background'. Please note that we may from time to time modify or update our cookies. When that happens, we will update our list accordingly.

### ***Targeting, Advertising or Tracking***

If you are a resident of a territory that provides the right to opt out of the sale or sharing of your personal information, or targeted advertising, you may exercise that choice in the Preferences tab of the Cookie consent tab. To do so, switch the toggle button to grey, then click "Save my preferences." If you do this, non-essential cookies, which collect information for analytics and to present you with targeted ads, will be disabled on our website.

### ***How do I manage cookies?***

You have the right to choose whether or not to accept cookies. You can control the way in which cookies are used by altering your browser settings. You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to reject cookies. Information about the procedure to follow in order to enable or disable cookies can be found on your Internet browser provider's website via your help screen. You may set your cookie settings on the Preferences tab of the cookie consent tab.

However, if you choose not to accept cookies, this may affect the functioning of our sites.

If you are using a mobile device, you can limit interest-based advertising on your device by adjusting the settings provided by your device manufacturer, such as "[Limit Ad Tracking](#)" for iOS or "[Opt-out of interest-based ads](#)" for Android.
